

# Creative Brief: LaunchDarkly Homepage Hero + Product Section Redesign

## Project Summary

LaunchDarkly is evolving from a feature flagging tool into the industry's first **Runtime Control Platform** for developers: one place to control every feature, release, and AI behavior in production. We want our homepage to better reflect this platform story, highlight our leadership in AI configuration control, and create a clearer, more modern way to explore our products from the hero down.

This brief asks you to concept and design an updated **homepage hero** and the **product discovery section** that sits directly below it.

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## Objectives

1. **Elevate LaunchDarkly as the platform for runtime control**, especially in the era of AI systems.
  2. **Communicate clearly that developers can control AI code, configs, prompts, parameters, models, fine-tuning, and agents**, not just traditional software features.
  3. **Strengthen our brand expression** (design, layout, typography, motion concepts).
  4. **Improve homepage discovery** so users can self-select their path through the platform (e.g., Release, Observe, Iterate / Flags, AI Configs, Experiments, Governance).
  5. **Modernize the visual tone** while staying aligned to our brand system (dark theme, gradients, toggles, motion cues).
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## Target Audience

- **Developers** (primary)
- **Platform engineering teams**
- **AI/ML engineers working with prompts, models, agents, and runtime configurations**
- **Engineering leaders looking for reliability, safety, and governance**

Visitors should immediately understand:

**“LaunchDarkly gives me control. Especially over AI.”**

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# Scope of Work

## 1. Homepage Hero Redesign

Create a refreshed hero section that includes:

### Mandatory elements

- A bold headline (candidate can propose new options or iterate from:  
**Control every feature.**)
- Subhead referencing AI control—e.g.:  
*One platform to control features, releases, and AI behavior — safely at runtime.*
- Primary CTA (Get a demo)
- Secondary CTA (Start building free)
- Optional mascot/illustration direction if it enhances storytelling
- Updated visual environment: layout, gradient treatment, motion concept, or art direction

### What we want to see

- Strong typography hierarchy

- Confident visual design, clean spacing
  - Brand-consistent but elevated
  - A point of view: what should LD *feel* like in 2025?
  - How do you visually represent “control” and “AI configuration”?
  - Simple interactions or motion ideas (even if described in words)
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## 2. Product Discovery Section (directly below hero)

We currently use a “Release / Observe / Iterate” toggle and product feature blurbs. We want this section redesigned to:

### Key goals

- Make it easier to explore the platform
- Highlight both **Feature Flags** and **AI Configs** equally
- Clarify the platform journey: Release → Observe → Iterate
- Emphasize that AI control is now a core LD capability
- Bring stronger visuals, structure, motion, and clarity to the section

### Required components

- Proposed new structure (cards, tabs, switcher, tiles—designer’s choice)
- Updated copy and visual approach to these capabilities:
  - Feature Flags
  - AI Configurations
  - Progressive Rollouts

- Targeting + segmentation
  - AI prompt + model manager
  - Experimentation
  - Governance / approvals
  - At least one visual mock / wireframe / concept
  - Ideas for how to show real product UI without clutter
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## Key Messages to Communicate

- **LaunchDarkly controls AI behavior at runtime**  
(prompts, parameters, model selection, guardrails, agent behavior, etc.)
  - **Safely deploy and iterate on AI features, just like software features**
  - **One unified platform for developers**
  - **Release → AI → Observe → Iterate**
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## Deliverables

- Figma frames or static mocks of:
  - Updated hero section
  - Updated product discovery section
- A short rationale (1–3 paragraphs) explaining:
  - Design decisions

- How this improves clarity & brand presence
  - How the concept communicates AI control
  - Optional: a quick animation/motion idea to show interactivity or transitions
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## Evaluation Criteria

We'll be reviewing for:

- Strength of **web design fundamentals**
- Ability to blend **brand + product storytelling**
- Clarity and hierarchy in layout
- Visual creativity + polish
- Conceptual understanding of AI control
- Ability to interpret and improve on an existing brand system
- Cohesiveness between hero and product section
- Clear rationale behind design decisions
